


BANDURIST ENSEMBLE

"DZVINHA"

Lviv, Ukraine



Bandurist ensemble "Dzvinha" was founded on December 1, 2000.

The main ideas that influenced the creation of "Dzvinha" were the popularization of Ukrainian music through the performance of banduras, as well as charitable work aimed at helping orphaned children.







The bandura is a Ukrainian plucked-string folk instrument. The use of lute-like stringed instruments by Ukrainians dates back to 591; however, the word "bandura" was first used in 1441.

Most of our members have been singing and playing the bandura since their childhood, which is why they are proficient in it.

The repertoire of "Dzvinha" includes a large number of works by different authors and styles, with a main focus on Ukrainian folk songs.











Until 2022, Dzvinha's main humanitarian activity was focused on raising funds to support orphaned children.

During this time, the organization developed a steady collaboration with four orphanages and a house for children with special needs.

Among the results of these collaborations are repairs to premises, replacement of windows and doors, technical equipment, purchase of medicines, furniture, toys, sports equipment, clothing for children, and more.

However, after the full-scale russian invasion of Ukraine, our organization shifted its focus to fundraising for humanitarian aid to the victims and providing essential support to Ukrainian defenders. For example, in 2022-2023, the organization acquired four off-road vehicles for the needs of our protectors, and assembled and delivered 300 "survival boxes" to the front line and liberated areas.







Humanitarian and charitable activities are made possible through the organization of concerts in Ukraine and close collaboration with the Belgian-Ukrainian Societies in Yvoir and Herzaux.

For 23 years, they have been organizing tours for our ensemble in Belgium every August.

During its existence, Dzvinha has also performed concerts in Poland, France, Macedonia, the Czech Republic, Slovakia, and Slovenia.
